## Get in the Holiday Spirit with Opera Kelowna

(**Kelowna, BC**) With the holidays on the horizon, Opera Kelowna wants to help you get in the festive spirit. *Amahl and the Night Visitors* takes the stage at the Rotary Centre for the Arts tonight (November 14) and runs through to November 16.

A 45-minute opera, Amahl captures the essential spirit of Christmas in a unique retelling of the compassionate story of the Three Kings. The Kings stop for shelter at the home of Amahl, a crippled shepherd boy who lives with his poor widowed mother, and the miracle of Christmas culminates in the boy's healing and universal joy.

The production will be conducted by Vancouver Opera's Maestro Leslie Dala with his son Andreas Dala starring in the title role.

Originally created by Gian Carlo Menotti - Amahl was the first opera to appear on television back in 1951 - and it maintains its broad appeal today. Amahl is a show which can be enjoyed by all ages, as Menotti himself explains:

"This is an opera for children because it tries to recapture my own childhood. You see, when I was a child I lived in Italy, and in Italy we have no Santa Claus. I suppose that Santa Claus is much too busy with American children to be able to handle Italian children as well. Our gifts were brought to us by the Three Kings, instead.

I actually never met the Three Kings—it didn't matter how hard my little brother and I tried to keep awake at night to catch a glimpse of the Three Royal Visitors, we would always fall asleep just before they arrived. But I do remember hearing them. I remember the weird cadence of their song in the dark distance; I remember the brittle sound of the camel's hooves crushing the frozen snow; and I remember the mysterious tinkling of their silver bridles…"

In addition to Amahl, attendees will be treated to 'Act II' as Opera Kelowna's singers perform classic arias and carols to make sure you're fully in festive mood.

Performances will take place at the Mary Irwin Theatre inside the Rotary Centre for the Arts at 7 p.m. on November 14 and 15 and 1 p.m. on November 16. Tickets range from \$49.95 to \$79.95 for VIPs (VIPs get prime seating as well as admission to a pre-opera VIP reception). Tickets can be purchased <a href="https://example.com/here">here</a>.
