RCA Presents: Indie-Folk Songwriter Chloe Davidson's Album Release Concert for *This Is Our Garden*

(Kelowna, BC) – The Rotary Centre for the Arts is thrilled to present Chloe Davidson and her band of beloved local musicians for an unforgettable evening celebrating the release of her second full-length record, *This Is Our Garden*. Taking place at the Mary Irwin Theatre on Saturday, November 21, this special event invites audiences to gather in song, reflection, and shared creativity. Davidson will perform solo and with her band, featuring Jordan Klassen, Andrew Judah, Drew Schulz, and Reid Schulz.

“Chloe Davidson is an exceptional songwriter and violinist and is a beloved fixture in the Okanagan's music scene. We're delighted to have her perform at the Mary Irwin Theatre,” says Andrew Stauffer, Theatre Programming Director.

This Is Our Garden is a heartfelt journey through orchestral pop, piano ballads, alt-rock, and Pete Seeger-inspired folk songs written for people to sing together. The album serves as a powerful call to recognize and harness our innate ability to create and heal, both within ourselves and in the world around us. This concert will be more than a performance; it is a communal celebration of the transformative power of collective love and creativity.

One of Canada's premiere singer-songwriters, Chloe Davidson pairs musical virtuosity with disarming vulnerability. Her 2022 debut album *Your Turn to Go* introduced audiences to her timeless and technically masterful songwriting, an artistry that has only deepened with her 2025 release *This Is Our Garden*. Drawing from folk, Americana, chamber pop, and ambient influences, she creates an immersive soundscape that invites listeners to tend both their inner and shared worlds with care.

Beyond her solo work, Davidson's collaborations with groups like Under the Rocks and artists such as Andrew Judah, Windmills, N. Sherman, Common Fires, and Icelandia have established her as one of British Columbia's most accomplished and versatile musicians.
