RCA Presents the Vancouver Chamber Choir, Canada's Longest-Running Professional Choral Ensemble

(Kelowna, BC) – The Rotary Centre for the Arts is pleased to present the Vancouver Chamber Choir with True *North*, an evocative program of choral works inspired by the northern landscapes of Canada, Estonia, Denmark, Latvia, and neighbouring regions. Under the direction of Artistic Director Kari Turunen, the performance takes place on Friday, December 6, at the Mary Irwin Theatre.

"Experiencing the beauty and purity of sixteen expert vocalists, breathing and singing together in an intimate theatre is a rare gift. I am beyond delighted to welcome our community to share this experience in the performance by the Vancouver Chamber Choir," says Andrew Stauffer, Theatre Programming Director.

True North showcases a curated selection of compositions shaped by the natural environments, cultural histories, and musical traditions of northern countries. The program highlights the emotional depth and distinct harmonic language that defines choral music from these areas, offering audiences an atmospheric and transportive evening.

Kari Turunen, one of Canada's leading choral conductors, has led the Vancouver Chamber Choir since 2019. Now in its 53rd season, the choir stands as Canada's longest-running professional choral ensemble. Founded in 1971 by Jon Washburn, the group has earned an international reputation for artistic excellence, diverse programming, and its longstanding commitment to contemporary choral music.

The Vancouver Chamber Choir has performed across Canada and around the world, including tours through Mexico, the USA, Europe, and Asia. Their work has been recognized with numerous honours, including Chorus America's prestigious Margaret Hillis Award for Choral Excellence. With 36 recordings, extensive broadcast history, and over 4,000 performances of Canadian works, the choir remains a driving force in advancing choral music at home and abroad. Their legacy of supporting composers includes 334 commissions and premieres from 145 composers and arrangers.
