

RCA Safety Measures for Community Programming

For a secure night of entertainment, RCA has implemented the following health and safety measures:

- Before entering the RCA building, patrons will be asked to fall in line by the main entrance. Floor markings are provided as a guide for appropriate social distancing.
- The main doors are the designated entrance, while the exit is towards Cawston Avenue near the theatre entrance.
- Patrons shall remain at home if they are feeling sick. They are also responsible for informing RCA of any COVID-19-related concerns before, during, and after the event.
- Wearing masks is strongly recommended as a precaution.
- Pre-registration is required. Audience members shall register online for their seats and sign in at the main entrance once they arrive.
- A limited number of people will be allowed inside the Atrium. A maximum of four (4) people of the same bubble will be seated in each table.
- Drinks are sold in the RCA Bistro. Patrons shall remain seated and wait to be served/assisted.
- As much as possible, the audience is advised to remain at the Atrium premises and to avoid loitering in the hallways.
- Sanitizing stations are placed in the building; people can wash or sanitize their hands upon entrance and from time to time.
- Washrooms are regularly disinfected, as well as other high-contact surfaces. Maximum of two (2) people at a time are allowed inside the washrooms.
- Performers will be at least three (3) meters away from the audience and two (2) meters away from each other.
- Everything brought into the venue should be packed out, except for properly recycled or disposed of products.
